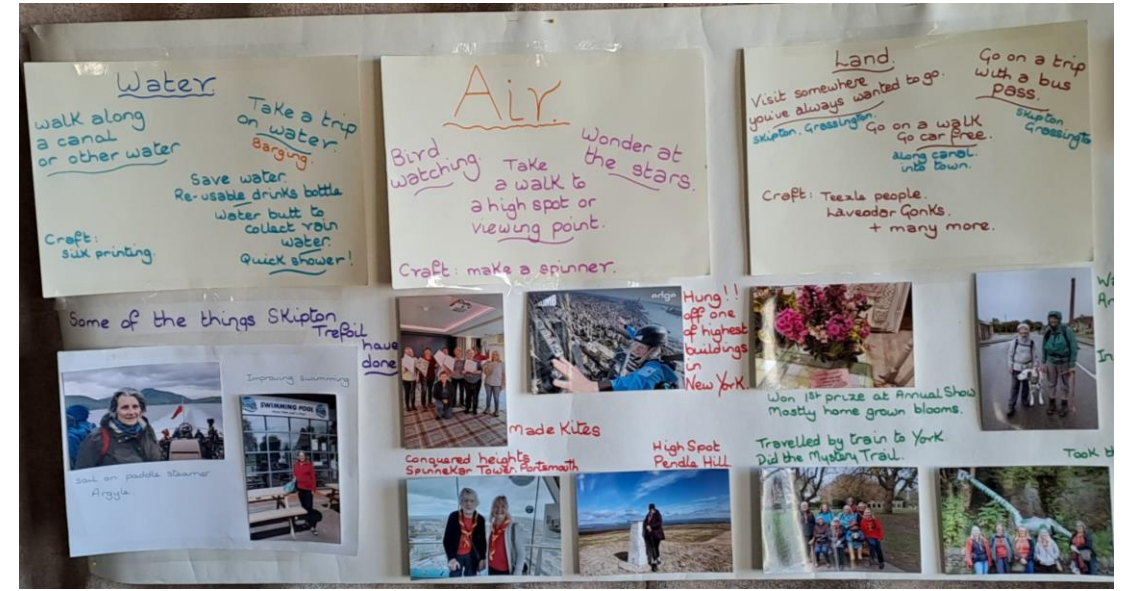

Premature baby hats and bereavement teddy bears were lovingly made to donate to local hospitals



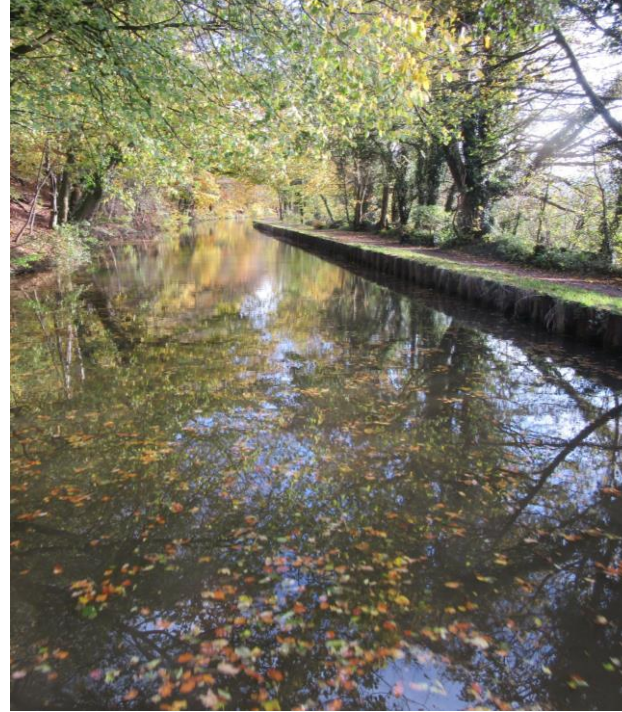
The weekend included many options and ideas for those members who had not done the Motivate challenge

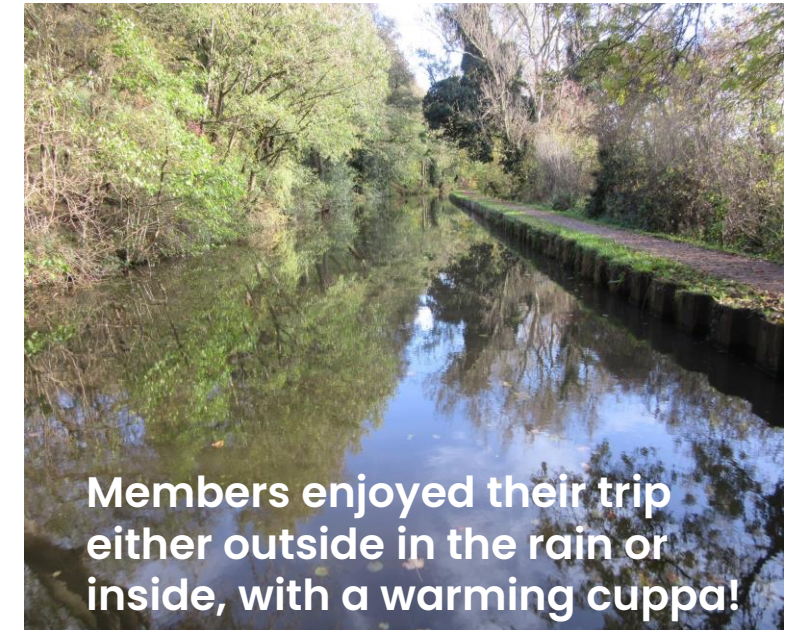
Thank you to them all for a fabulous trip.

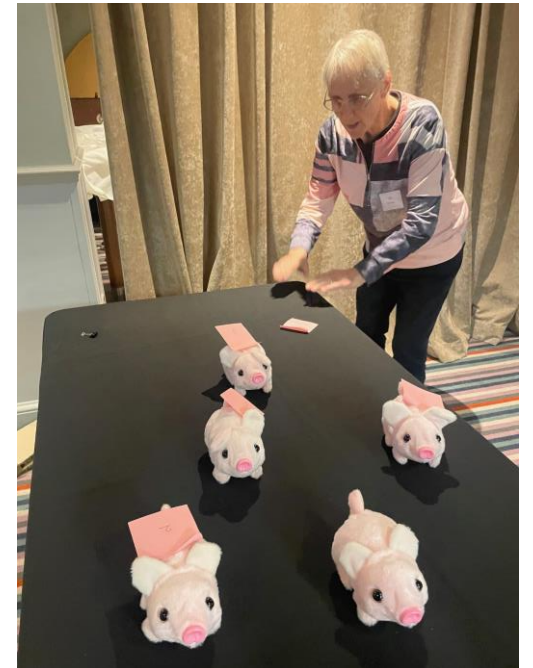

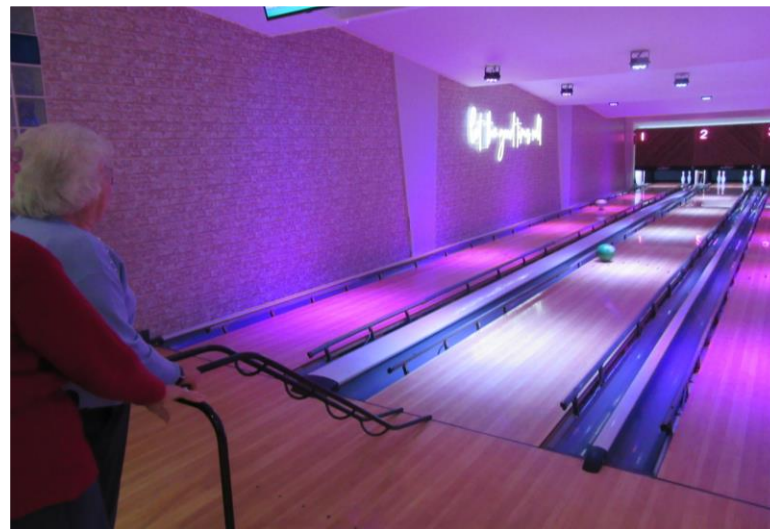
The winner with the highest score was Mary Potter. Presented with her prize by Lesley who won it in the £2 grab-a-toy machine onsite
